- Career Path

- Police career

- State Representative on Beacon Hill

- District Attorney position

- Detective Division: 17 years; Chief Detective

- 32 years in Salem

- Huge diversity of exposure and opportunities

- Undercover drug work

- Theme of career: always learning

- Key Experiences & Lessons

- 328 drug arrests in one year in Salem

Learning: most were not "big shots" – many had treatment and rehab issues

- Opportunities for second chances and rehab should exist

- "When you've really made it" story:

For Paul, fame meant Boston TV

- As a young detective, robberies targeting pizza delivery drivers in Salem

Helped solve the case

Commended in Domino's national newsletter (30,000 franchises)

That's when you've made it

- Notable Incident – February 11, 1997

Car chase originating in NH (from

Seabrook) Came through Beverly

Paul was Captain of Detectives

9:00 AM – sitting in Salem with coffee and donuts

In Essex: VW Jetta; suspect comes out of sunroof and shoots at the chief (no injuries)

Salem cops block the bridge

Suspect hits a curb and goes over cruisers

Only Paul in pursuit

Suspect crashes, runs with a gun and

pillowcase full of cash

Runs into Tom Brophy's backyard

Hostage situation – ended well

- Interview & Interrogation

Interview the worst arrestees – build rapport

- Techniques: Rationalize, Project, Minimize (RPM)

No one admits a crime outright – you have to get them talking

- 1997: FBI Academy, Quantico, VA

Best class: interview and interrogation Sue Adams (FBI Agent)

Susan Smith case (SC): cracked due to past-tense language about her kids

- Legally, you can't lie – but you can create a scenario where the suspect thinks you know more than you do

- Community Impact & Reform

- 2009: Kim Driscoll created the Community Impact Unit

- Addressed gap between serious crimes and call-to-call beat work

- Focused on populations in the shadows

- Contracted social services

- Created a four-person unit (often dual diagnosis)

- Model adopted across New England and the country

- 2013: Police trip to Israel (career highlight)

- Salem runs the largest events north of Boston: Halloween Haunted Happenings

Shift from local to international event = more complexity and security

- Ronnie Tabee (police officer; husband also police officer)

- Terrorist attack blew up a bus

- She was blown through the roof

Returned to work 2.5 years later

- Spoke to 13 police executives

Wanted to return to work and take the same route where the bombing occurred

Powerful speech

- 2014: State Representative

Judiciary Committee, Public Safety Committee

- Police reform (controversial)

- Licensure for police: we license beauticians, plumbers, electricians – why not police?

- Reform moved forward; sky didn't fall

- Solitary confinement reform

- Prison reform

- District Attorney Role

Had never prosecuted a case, but extensive court experience

- Elected DA of Essex County

34 cities and towns

Just under 1 million people

Fourth day on the job: first shooting – 3:00 AM call

- Focus on wellness for police officers and DAs

- Exposure to trauma others don't see

- Grand jury service reveals shocking details behind headlines

- First three officers involved had 32, 15, and 8 weeks on the job

- Nothing like it seen before

- Shift from "wellness = drinking beer"

- Introduction of CISM (Critical Incident Stress Management)

Especially for first responders




