Doc Wiley – 30 years

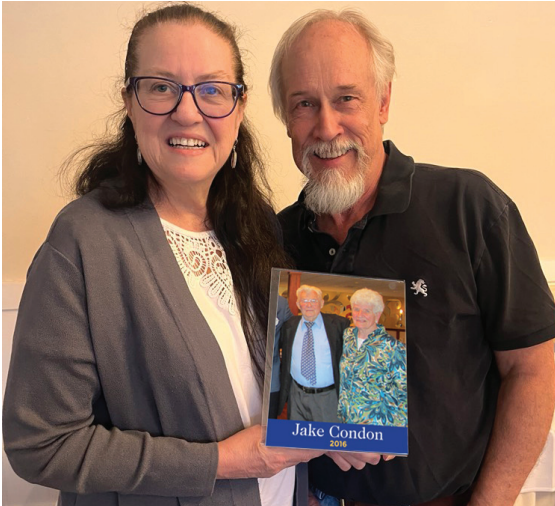
It was a beautiful and moving tribute — a reminder that Rotary’s heart is its people, past and present.
