



Things like Riispuuro, Kaalikaaryleet, Graavilohi and the extremly delicious Korvapuusti! She uses a candle-lit wreath to light her way, leaving her hands free to carry as much food as possible. In Finland, the day is celebrated with lots of candles and formal celebrations in every Finnish town. Traditionally, the eldest girl in the family portrays St. Lucia, donning a white robe and a crown of candles. She serves her parents buns, cookies, coffee, or mulled wine. Here in USA we use Dr Jamie, dressed in plaid bringing gifts of Ho, Ho's and twinkies.
