



Speaker

Jo Broderick introduces our speaker. Jonathan Cassidy from Elite Detectives: Private Investigator & Detective Services. He specializes in Security consulting and training. Also, provides protection for high profile celebrities. While serving as a constable in the city of Beverly.

He would elaborate on services that they provide including background checks for employers, worker's compensation investigations, and personal injury cases. A great deal of the work includes surveillance and researching documentation. As a company,



they view each case that comes in as a team. They come up with a game plan and implement. He showed examples of employees that were out on a disability claim due to an injury. He showed pictures of them on ladders and painting a home but supposedly could not stand for long periods of time. While doing background checks for employers they would investigate their Social media accounts, talk to former employers and perform criminal background checks. Once all the information is gathered, they would provide a full report with recommendations. He also is also an Active Shooter survival trainer. He does this type of training for business and schools. In an active shooter situation, he stressed the importance of taking a breath so that you can make the proper decision and not panic.
